Thanksgiving Service this evening at 7pm, followed by a shortened Communion Service.

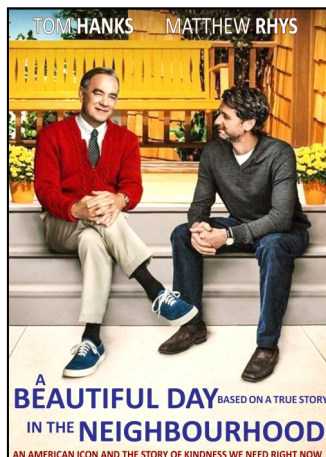
