You are warmly welcomed to join us for worship in First Omagh Church. Changes to Covid Mitigations from Sunday 6th March 2022 - Following guidance from Assembly Buildings we will no longer be required to keep a record of attendance for Track and Trace purposes and all church pews will be available to use. We strongly encourage people to sit in an empty pew and continue to maintain a 1m social distance from others at all times. Face coverings will continue to be worn, unless exempt, whilst moving around and when standing to sing but may be removed whilst seated. The use of hand sanitisers, the one way system and a retiring offering will continue for now. Announcement sheets should be collected on your way into church.
