



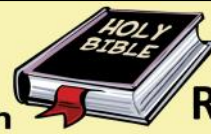

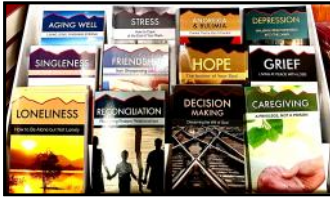
Revelation 2:12-17
