Donations towards expenses will be much appreciated.

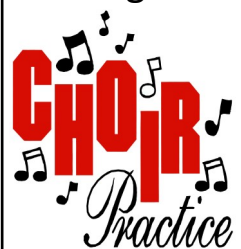


HARVEST SUNDAY 8th OCT
