Sunday lunch resumes on Sunday 28th January. Those planning to attend should put their name on the sheets provided in the vestibule table bv latest todav.









Dr Anne Zaki grew up in Cairo in a pastor's home. She is married to Rev Naji Umran and they have four sons.

Dr Zaki holds a Bachelor's degree in Psychology and Sociology from Calvin University, USA; a Master's degree in Social Psychology from the American University, Cairo; a Master's of Divinity from Calvin Theological Seminary; and



a PhD in theology with a concentration on preaching from Fuller Theological Seminary.

Having worked as a resource development specialist, a psychologist and a counsellor, and served together with her husband in churches in Michigan and British Columbia, Dr Zaki has served as a Professor of Preaching and Practical Theology at the Evangelical Theological Seminary in Cairo, Egypt since 2013.
